All of Fragua's pottery is made with natural materials from the earth at Jemez Pueblo, including her paints and clay. According to Fragua, "I am very interested in continuing the art of pottery making which has been a part of my culture for many years." She is currently

passing the tradition onto her immediate family, including her husband, two daughters and son.

Linda was awarded 2nd Place - Pottery at the Tesoro Cultural Center's 2005 Indian Market and she took 1st Place - Pottery at the Tesoro Cultural Center's 2007 Indian Market & Powwow and in 2009 she won 1st Place in Pottery at Tesoro.
