Catherine is a textile designer, ledger artist and painter. Catherine has a men's shirt collection in which she incorporates her Seminole designs in a war shirt strip, as well as animal designs. Catherine has won awards for her regalia in traditional dresses. Catherine's ledger art and paintings reflect her Seminole culture in a fresh contemporary form.

She is also adopted by the leader of the Blackfeet Horns Society and was transferred a straight up head dress. Catherine attends shows nationwide and has won several awards including 1st Place at the Eiteljorg Museum in 2004, 1st Place at the SWAIA Native American Clothing Contest 2004, and received Honorable Mentions at the SWAIA Native American Clothing Contest 04-07. She

was also a participant at the Smithsonian Museum of American Indian D.C. in 2007 as well as at the Heard Museum Painted Pony Featured Artist, with her husband Terrance in 2008. In 2009 Catherine won 2nd Place in Traditional Arts at Tesoro Cultural Center's Indian Market.
