DIRECTIONS

From Downtown Denver: Take 6th Ave west to I-70 west. I-70 west to C-470, the Colorado Springs exit (exit #260). C-470 to Hwy 285 south, the Fairplay exit. After exiting C-470 onto 285 you will be in the mountains. Travel 1 1/2 miles up Hwy 285 to your first exit that reads Hwy 8 Morrison Evergreen exit. We are located approximately 300 yards north on the east side.

From Boulder: Take Hwy 93 south to 6th Ave. Sixth Ave East to C-470, taking the Colorado Springs exit. C-470 to Hwy 285 south, the Fairplay exit. At that point you will be in the mountains. Travel 1 1/2 miles up Hwy 285 to your first exit that reads Hwy 8 Morrison Evergreen exit. We are located approximately 300 yards north on the east side.

From Colorado Springs: I-25 north to Hwy C-470 west (exit #194). You will be on C-470 for approximately 13 miles. From C-470 you will exit to Hwy 285 south, the Fairplay exit. At that point you will be in the mountains. Travel 1 1/2 miles up Hwy 285 to your first exit that reads Hwy 8 Morrison Evergreen exit. We are located approximately 300 yards north on the east side.

From Evergreen: Take Hwy 74 east to Hwy 8, which is the first stoplight in Morrison. Turn right at the light on Hwy 8 and travel 2 1/2 miles south on Hwy 8. The Fort is located on the left side of the road on the other side of the big red rock.
