Pottery*



Although born of traditional Navajo parents, Bob Lansing creates non-traditional pottery masterpieces. Influenced by the work of renowned Santa Clara potter Joseph Lonewolf, Lansing began to carve and incise designs onto “greenware” (commercially produce pottery) while still in his teens. Later he was encouraged by fellow potters to create his own pottery. He now does, and it is even less traditional than most contemporary pottery because it is thrown on a wheel and fired in a kiln. He excels in animal motifs and designs of Navajo and Pueblo origin.
