His grandfather taught him about traditional dancing as well as life and spirituality. Lynn Burnette has created a unique style of painting using instant tea but also paints with oil and acrylic on canvas and does bronze sculptures. In 2010, Lynn won 3rd place in Sculpture at Tesoro Indian Market.
