Gabriel Sice is a third generation fetish carver from the Pueblo of Zuni, New Mexico. His main mediums for his carvings are deer and elk antler but often works with other mediums such as Belgium marble, Picasso marble, serpentine, mother of pearl shell and lapis. Mr. Sice

is known for his carvings of standing bears, badgers, frogs, parrots and pueblo maidens with inlay of Sleeping Beauty Turquoise and Mediterranean Coral. In 2017, Mr. Sice has begun transitioning into carving larger sculptures out of stone such as Virginia steatite, honeycomb calcite and various Utah alabasters. He frequently exhibits at local and national art shows if interested in viewing more of his artwork.
